

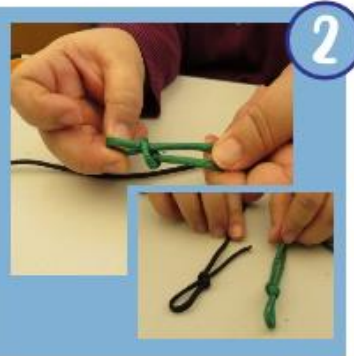
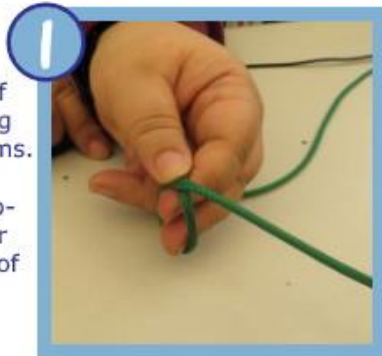


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# Take and Make FEB 2021

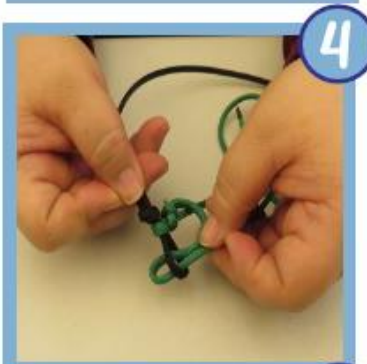
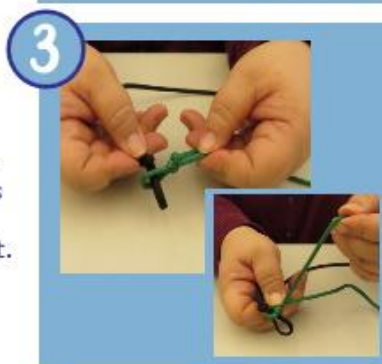
## PARACORD: SLIP KNOT

Start with two lengths of paracord that are as long as your outstretched arms. Make a slip knot on the end of each cord by looping the cord around your fingers, folding the end of the cord and pulling it through your loop.



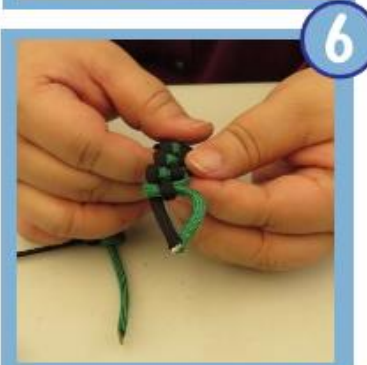
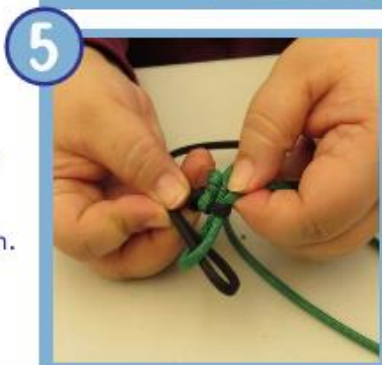
Complete your slip knot by tightening the cord. You can adjust the size of the loop by sliding the cord up and down. Make sure you have several inches of free cord for finishing the bracelet later.

Place one of your cord's loops through the other loop. Tighten both cords by pulling the shorter ends and forming a knot.



Alternating between cords, place the loops through the other loops, tightening as you go. For best results make sure your cord is not twisted.

Repeat steps 3 and 4 until the braided length is long enough to fit around your wrist, or until your desired length.



Choose the end of your bracelet that has less free cord to make the loop. Seal the loop by melting the ends and clamping them together with a pliers.

Knot the remaining cord ends close to the braid, then make another knot an inch or so from the end. Cut and burn the remaining thread to finish your bracelet.



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
