If you are able, help outside by removing snow either at your home, or for a neighbor.	Use a phone, Facetime, Zoom or other means to talk with a someone. Share a happy memory or joke!	Read a book that was made into a movie, or a book that was made about a movie.
Write a positive note on a piece of paper and hide it in your house. How long will it take for someone to find?	Read a book that has more pictures than words, OR Read a book with more words than pictures.	Try making a new meal or snack using a recipe or cookbook. What will you make?	Read a nonfiction book about something you are interested in.	Send a thank you card to essential workers like: nurses, EMS, police, fire, store workers, and many others!
Read a fiction book set in the past, future, or a different kind of present day.	Make a list of the things you are thankful for. When you are done, decorate the list!	FREE VPL SPACE	Donate a non-perishable food item to a local food shelf or little free pantry.	Read a book that is about MN, or was written by someone from Minnesota.
On a cold day go outside with a bubble wand and blow bubbles. What happens?	Read a book that you have read before, but still like to read.	Play a game you enjoy. This could be a board game, puzzle, card game, or something else.	Read a book that is older than you, OR Read a book that is younger than you.	Go outside at night to see the stars. Can you find any planets or constellations?
Practice reading out loud to a person, animal, or object OR listen to someone reading a book out loud.	Tell each person you live with something that you like about them.	Build something out of snow. It could be a fort, a snowman, or anything you would like!	Find out one real event that happened the year you were born. What did you learn about?	Read a book while wrapped in a blanket, or read inside a blanket fort.
